High Tower Comics is Corona’s first comic book publisher. The publishing company was founded by Corona native John C. Narcomey, Jr. (Creative Director/ Graphic Novelist) and Southern California native Jacob Crippen (Illustrator). This independent publishing house opened in the November 2008 with the publication of four comic book titles: *Jungle Jive*, *Ghostface*, *Heiroglyphs*, and *Spooksville* (published in association with *Lucky Squid*). By July 2009 two new titles had been added to the High Tower Comics publishing list: *Smart Bullets* and *Space Boogie*. High Tower creative team describe their comics as a “sample genres ranging from pulps, grind house, B-movies, sci-fi old timey serials and classic screwball farce to lay our original voices and talents over<sup>1</sup>.”
