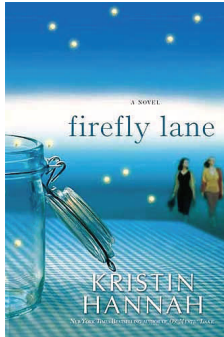

## **Firefly Lane** by Kristin Hannah

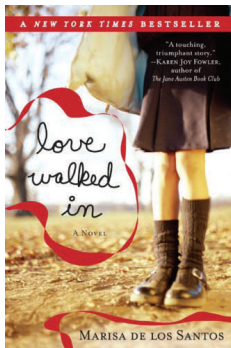
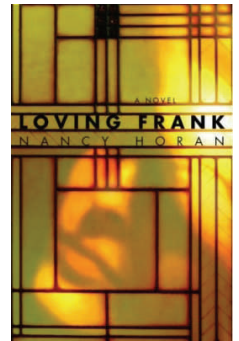

## **Love Walked In** by Marisa De los Santos

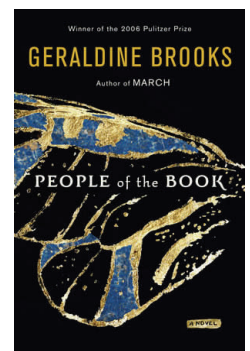
